TRILLIUM TOUR APRIL 12, 2008 10:00AM—NOON

- Trails will be muddy, and it could rain, so wear hiking boots and clothing for wet weather. Bring your cameras. Absolutely no picking of trilliums allowed - if you pick them they will not come back next year!
- There is no sign up and there is no cost.
- The walk will start at the little ring. Park at Ben Franklin Elementary school, 12434 NE 60th Street, Kirkland and walk south on the powerline dirt road (you will cross 60th). You will walk past private homes and pastures and soon enter the Park. The little ring (an equestrian arena) will be on your right once you enter the Park.
