Salamanders

- x *Ambystoma gracile*, Northwestern Salamander. In and near ponds and slow streams.
- x *Ambystoma macrodactylum*, Long-toed Salamander. In many habitats, usually near water.
- x *Taricha granulosa*, Rough-skinned Newt. In and near ponds.
- x *Ensatina eschscholtzi*, Ensatina. In forest.
- Plethodon vehiculum*, Western Redback Salamander. In conifer forest.

Frogs

- x *Pseudacris regilla*, Pacific Chorus Frog. Almost ubiquitous, especially near water.
- x *Rana aurora*, Red-legged Frog. Near or in ponds, especially in forest.

Reptiles

- Elgaria coerulea*, Northern Alligator Lizard. Forest.
- Thamnophis elegans*, Western Terrestrial Garter Snake. Open woodland and wetlands.
- x *Thamnophis ordinoides*, Northwestern Garter Snake. Moist woodland, wetlands, and meadows.
- Thamnophis sirtalis*, Common Garter Snake. Open woodland, meadows, and wetlands.
