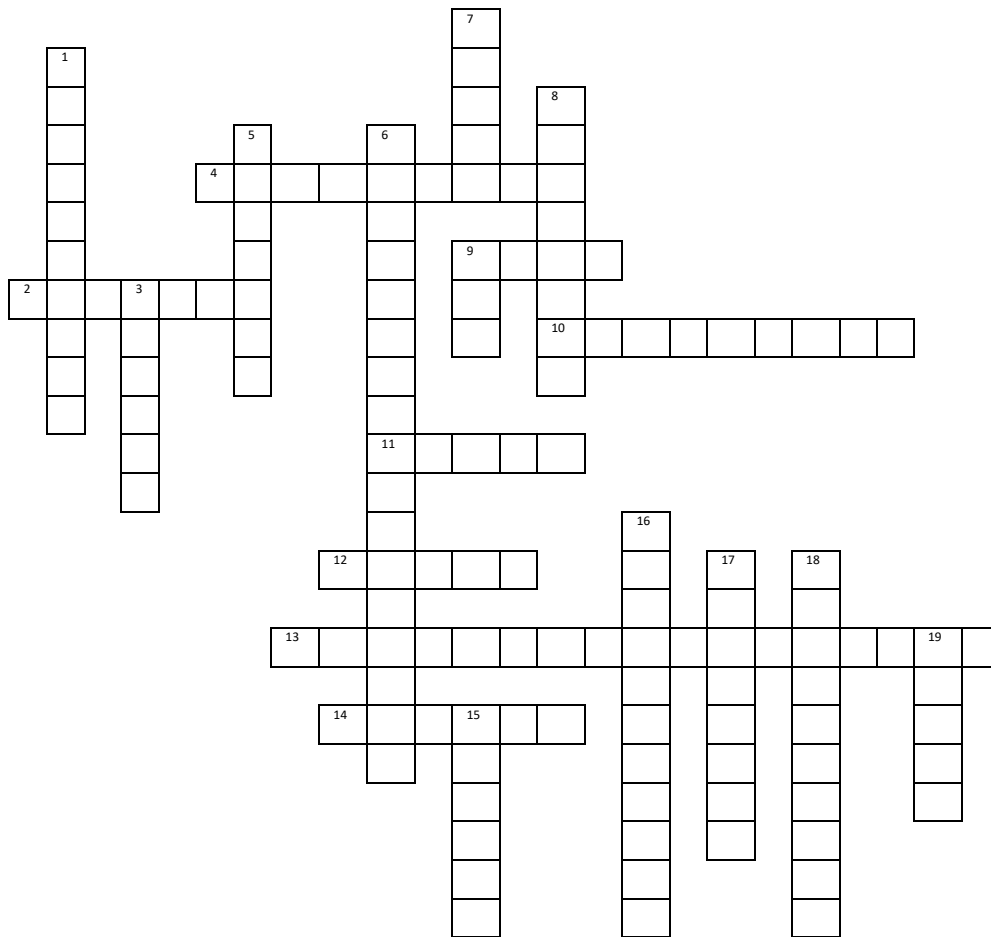


Bridle Trails State Park Crossword Puzzle
