Find the item(s) and draw them in the box on the right!

<p>Deciduous Leaf</p> <p>Deciduous trees have leaves that fall off in the winter. How many different kinds can you find?</p>	
<p>Coniferous Needles</p> <p>Coniferous trees have needles that stay on the tree all year long. How many different kinds can you find?</p>	
<p>Bark</p> <p>Draw the bark of two different trees. Bark is used to identify types of trees.</p>	
<p>Spider Web</p> <p>Spiders have unique webs that they build as their homes. They use the web to catch prey and protect themselves.</p>	

Bird

Draw a scientific drawing (sketch with notes and comments about color, song, where you found it, etc.) of a bird you spotted.

Log

Logs are important parts of forests – they help put nutrients back into the soil and create habitat for insects. Try to find one with something growing out of it – this is called a nurse log.

Flower

Many flowers in forests grow on bushes. Can you find one flower on a bush and one on the ground? One of our trails is named after a very special flower that grows here.

Animal Print

What animal prints can you find? They are easiest to find in mud near a trail.
